



# WIOA 2018-2019 Youth Program Eligibility Requirements



## Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Out of School Youth
- Reside in San Bernardino County
- Be between the ages of 16-24

## Must meet at least one criteria to apply:

	<b>Homeless</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Statement from an individual providing temporary shelter</li> <li>• Statement from Social Service Agency</li> <li>• Self-Attestation</li> </ul>
	<b>In Foster care or who has aged out of the foster care system</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Statement/Referral from Social Services Agency</li> <li>• Court/Guardianship documents</li> <li>• Self-Attestation</li> </ul>
	<b>Pregnant or Parenting Youth</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Child's Birth Certificate (BC)</li> <li>• Baptismal Record</li> <li>• Verification from doctor verifying pregnancy</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> If using parenting teen for father, must have his name on Birth Certificate as father</p>
	<b>Disability</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medical Record</li> <li>• School Record/IEP-last year attended</li> <li>• Social Security Disability Record</li> <li>• Vocational rehabilitation letter/statement</li> </ul>
	<b>Compulsory School</b> A youth who is within the age of compulsory school attendance, but has not attended school for at least the most recent complete school year quarter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School Records</li> </ul>
	<b>Low Income and BSD/ESL</b> A recipient of a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent who is a low income individual and is either Basic Skills Deficient or an English Language Learner	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Standardized Test approved by the National Reporting System</li> <li>• IEP indicating youth is ESL</li> </ul>

*To start the eligibility process with **Pathways Management Group**, please bring the following items:*

- Birth Certificate
- School ID or California ID/DL
- Social Security Card
- School Transcripts or HS Diploma
